

During 2003, Ohio law changed with respect to the filing requirements for tangible personal property business returns. It is no longer necessary for a 920 form to be filed by a taxpayer if the total listed value is below \$10,000. This **does not** include filing a 920NT for new taxpayers, which is still required regardless of the amount.

In order to update and properly maintain the tax records of each business in the County, please provide the information listed below and return it to 112 E. Mansfield St., Suite 105, Bucyrus, Ohio 44820 as soon as possible.

If the total listed value of your business is below the \$10,000, the information requested below will only be necessary one time. However, should the total listed value of your business exceed the \$10,000, the 920 form will need to be filed for the applicable tax year.
